Located in the heart of the town, St Peter's is the Civic and Parish Church of Bournemouth. The Neo-Gothic building is impressive, especially the interior with many interesting and magnificent features. Music has been a strong tradition; the organ is Grade 1 listed and, on this occasion, will be played by the same NEU member as at last year's Liverpool Cathedral service.
