PROCEDURE

Nominations for all positions are to be made on the enclosed form. Further copies are available from the Union Office. All nominations must be accompanied by the signatures of the nominee, proposer and seconder, all of whom must be current members of the NEU (including NUT & ATL Sections).

If there is more than 1 nomination for an officer post then nominees may need to submit a single written statement of up to 75 words in support of their nomination, which will be included on the ballot paper. If this limit is exceeded, only the first 75 words will be printed. Should no statement be received, this will be indicated on the ballot paper.
